Dance Rules for Seccina Memorial High School. (Please read and sign)

1. Once you enter the dance, you must remain on campus, in the designated areas until you are ready to leave for the evening. When leaving, you must leave the grounds and may not return. No loitering is allowed in the parking lot.
2. Students who do not drive themselves to the dance must be picked up no later than 15 minutes after the end of the dance.
3. All guests must have a valid picture ID to verify eligibility to attend a dance.
4. Any person suspended or expelled from any school may not attend a dance or any other school function.
5. The dress requirements will be enforced at the door. When in doubt, ask.
6. Students who dance in an inappropriate manner will be reminded of the proper dance limits and if they do not conform will be asked to leave the dance and will not receive a refund of the admission fee.
Parents will be notified if students have been asked to leave the dance.
7. Please do not leave valuables unattended. The school assumes no responsibility for loss or theft of items.
8. Students are to remember that the Seccina Parent/Student Handbook rules apply to all participants at any school function, including dances. Failure to comply with the rules may result in potential loss of afterschool activities and events or other disciplinary actions.

FORMAL DRESS CODE

Boys

- Traditional male attire required
- Dress shirt with a tie (exception: tuxedo shirt with a decorative button). Shirts must remain on and tucked in for the entire dance
- Dress pants or dress jeans
- Undergarments must NOT be revealed
- Jackets optional

Girls

- Dresses must be no shorter than a hand length above the knee
- Undergarments must NOT be revealed
- Bare midriffs and plunging necklines are not allowed
- Backs may not be lower than the natural waistline
- See-through material which exposes thighs, excessive cleavage, or midriff is not permitted
- Slits may not be longer than fingertip length
- Pantsuits must be of a formal nature (no jeans)

FOOTWEAR

- All attendees must always wear footwear. Non-formal shoes for dancing comfort may be worn.
