Crusaders Head Football Coach **Ott Hurrle '70** won his 200th game overall during the first-round Sectional game against Centerville on Oct. 25 and his 200th game for Scecina against Shenandoah on Nov. 1. He is the 68th winningest coach all-time in the state of Indiana and ranks 20th among active coaches.

"I really never gave it much thought, but it feels good," Coach Hurrle told "The Red and Gold Show," Scecina's student-produced news program. "Another thing telling me I'm really getting old." Hurrle said Scecina's two state championship wins in 1990 and 1991 remain the highlights of his career, a 40-year career he doesn't see ending anytime soon.

"It's still a lot of fun," he said. "I enjoy being with the coaches, the players. We're really fortunate at Scecina that we've got really great players and great coaches to be around."

Mr. Dellacca has been guiding many of our school efforts with grace and intelligence. He is serving with a high level of commitment, energy, and enthusiasm.

Mr. Dellacca and I began the interim principal arrangement with the complete understanding that a public search and selection process would begin near the midpoint of the 2019-20 year. That time has come, and the selection process has begun as planned.

The process will include listening sessions among Scecina students, staff, and parents, as well as a six-question online survey all our students, parents, and staff received. In addition, a search committee will begin meeting by February 2020. This group will suggest candidates to interview based on applications and will help me interview and appraise candidates. My goal is to announce the principal selection to the Scecina Community in April 2020, or in May if necessary.

This edition of the magazine also includes our annual financial report for the 2018-19 fiscal year. Again, for the 10th consecutive year, Scecina operated in the black. It's all thanks to you, our supporters, friends, and donors. Your generosity is visible every day in every way at the school.

Thank you, and thanks to our great faculty and staff, for making Scecina a great Catholic high school!

## SCECINA STUDENT PUTS HIS HEART INTO FUNDRAISER

Suicide prevention, mental health and firefighting are issues close to the heart of Scecina junior **Elijah Clegg**.

He lost his brother, **Zac**, to suicide. Zac was a freshman at Roncalli High School and Elijah was 10 at the time.

His dad, **Steve Clegg**, a 1990 Scecina graduate, is a firefighter.

Elijah decided last summer to create a fun event to raise money for those causes. He set a goal of raising \$1,500. Local TV stations broadcast stories about Elijah and his fundraiser. Roncalli also promoted the event.

On Sept. 1, people from all over the city came together at the Indianapolis Firefighters Local 416

Union Hall in Downtown Indy for Elijah's fundraiser, Cookout for Life. He raised \$8,600, way above his goal.

"It was insanely amazing. I was thinking too small," said Elijah, who also takes part in band, Rock Band, theatre and cross country at Scecina. "I'm very proud of the results and the people who showed up."

The funds from the September fundraiser were split between the American Foundation for Suicide Prevention (AFSP) and Local 416 Peer Support Fund to help firefighters dealing with mental health or emotional issues.

After his brother's death, suicide prevention became a major cause for Elijah's family, including his mom, **Amy (Montgomery) Clegg**, Scecina Class of 1994.
They organized a group called Zac's Amazing Crew to walk in the AFSP's Out of the Darkness Community Walk.

Elijah said he got "an adrenaline rush" from seeing all the people show up and support him. He said he'll do it again.

"We're talking to more bands, adding a few other surprises, and more featured speakers," he said.

## SCECINA'S CANNED FOOD DRIVE: A LONG-STANDING TRADITION

The Scecina Student Council's Canned Food Drive tradition continued in 2019 with a school goal of collecting 10,000 cans.

"The canned food drive is important to the school because Scecina has participated in it for a long time, and it is a great way for the Scecina community to come together for a great cause," said **Bailey Sims**, senior class president.

The food was donated to the local St. Vincent de Paul.

"So, we're doing our part to help, because St. Vincent de Paul serves 3,000 families a week," Bailey said.

The campaign kicked off on Halloween with a school pep rally and prizes for students' costume. The drive ended Nov. 22, when the students created an assembly line to move 13,381 cans onto the St. Vincent de Paul truck.

"We have participated in the canned food drive since I was a student here, and I think even my mom participated when she was a student," said Social Studies Department Chair and Student Council moderator Nikki (Runner) Rosswurm, Class of 2005. "It's a long-standing tradition here at Scecina."

Over the years, the cans have gone to different places, she said. For the past three to four years Scecina's cans have been donated to St.

"Each week St. Vincent de Paul helps over 3,000 families in our community," said Ms. Rosswurm, "and StuCo likes to help them accomplish that."

No student is required to participate in the drive, but each student has an individual goal of 30 cans or non-perishable items. Students who reached their goal of 30 cans could dress out one school day. The winning class received doughnuts and coffee on Nov. 27 before school.



## 2019 FATHER TOM SERVICE AWARD

Scecina volunteer **Frank Sergi** paid tribute to his late wife, Scecina graduate **Trish (McMahon) Sergi '73**, and many other "saints" as he received the Father Tom Service Award on Oct. 24.

This year marked the 75th anniversary of the death of Father Thomas Scecina, the school's namesake, who perished aboard a Japanese POW ship during World War II on Oct. 24, 1944.

The Father Tom Service Award is given annually to a person who believes in the importance of Scecina Memorial High School and, as Father Tom did during his life, lives the motto of "give that little extra" every day.

Sergi, a former teacher and coach, is an active and dedicated Scecina volunteer through his faith-based counseling efforts with dozens of Scecina students, especially students who are 21st Century Scholars. He cares deeply about these young people and has made a difference in many of their lives.

Sergi accepted the award after a special Mass attended by all Scecina students and staff, his family and friends, and many representatives from the Indianapolis Catholic education community.

Sergi's most emotional tribute was to his late wife, **Trish**, for whom a Scecina endowment is named.

"My favorite and most caring saint and angel in heaven is someone who influenced my life more than anyone. She was an extraordinary person who attended Scecina and sat where you are 50 years ago, in the fall of 1969," Sergi told the students sitting in the bleachers. "My wife of 37 years and special education teacher her entire professional career and the mother of our three children, Mark, Tim and Monica ... Trish McMahon Sergi. While I miss her, I'll never forget her, and I know she is with Jesus Christ, smiling and cheering the Scecina school song."

Scecina President Joe Therber noted Sergi's dedication to Catholic education. "He has a deep-rooted faith in God and a belief in every young person's potential. Living this belief motivates him to serve at Scecina," he said.

## FORMER NASA ASTRONAUT JOSE HERNANDEZ INSPIRES SCECINA STUDENTS

Jose Hernandez has traveled from his childhood on a migrant farm to space and back. Traveling to Downtown Indianapolis to speak to high school students was an easy and fun journey.

Seventy Scecina students were among an estimated 1,500 other high schoolers from Central and Southern Indiana attending the Indiana Latino Institute's Sixth Annual Education Summit and College and Career Fair, where Hernandez spoke on Nov. 20.

The summit's emcee was Indianapolis TV news anchor **Rafael Sanchez**. Sanchez, a native of the Dominican Republic, asked where the students or their families were from, naming numerous countries from Honduras to Guatemala to Mexico. The high school audience showed its deep roots in Latino countries. Sanchez and Hernandez both switched easily between English and Spanish as they spoke to the students.

Hernandez was born in California but traveled back to Mexico for half of each year until he was in second grade. He spoke only Spanish until he was 12. After watching the final Apollo mission to the moon in 1972, he told his papa he wanted to become an astronaut with NASA, an idea his father did not discourage or dismiss.

Hernandez earned a bachelor's degree in electrical engineering and a master's degree in electrical and computer engineering and then applied to NASA for its astronaut training program. He was denied 11 times. He tried a 12th time and was accepted. In 2009, he flew on a 14-day space shuttle mission to the International Space Station.

Hernandez's message to the students is easy to understand in any language: "I followed my dreams as a Latino American, and you can too." He sprinkled humor and motivation into his talk, showing the students a slick biographical video that included some awkward teen photos, as well as cool footage of him floating in the spacecraft.

He clearly inspired the Scecina students. Several said they learned to persevere, no matter what their situation.

"We need to remember where we came from and that Latino is the future," said senior **Stephanie Garcia**.

"I liked having people from different countries coming together to celebrate our similarities," said sophomore **Alejandro Mendoza**.

Amy Fix, chair of Scecina's World Language Department, said the students' positive reaction to Hernandez's talk has inspired her to reach out to other successful Latinos in Indiana to speak to her students. Susana Rivera-Mills, provost and executive vice president for academic affairs at Ball State University, will speak at Scecina in February.

## A STUDENT'S MINISTRY OF MUSIC

At Scecina, students take part in the school Mass liturgy as servers, lectors and Eucharistic ministers. And music ministers, with a liturgical choir and junior **Anthony Higgins** playing the piano.

Music ministry runs in Anthony's family. He's the son of **Jeff** and **Judith (Joson) Higgins '84**. His sister **Monica**, Scecina Class of 2018, served in the liturgical choir at Scecina and helped plan school liturgy. His brother **Jonny**, Scecina Class of 2012, played for Scecina Masses while he was a student and now is the director of music and coordinator of youth education and ministry at St. Michael in Greenfield.

Playing the piano at Mass is a unique opportunity to serve the Scecina community and improve his keyboard skills, said Anthony, who has been playing at Scecina since his freshman year.

"Anthony truly exemplifies Scecina's call to servant leadership," said **K.J. Fallon**, Scecina's liturgy coordinator. "Through his musical talents and creative inputs, Anthony is able to create a sacred and prayerful space for worship, in a school gym, to ultimately bring others moments to encounter Christ."

Anthony also has filled in at Masses at his parish, Our Lady of Lourdes Catholic Church, when its music director is off, and at St. Michael.

Anthony, who started taking piano lessons at age 6, also plays the saxophone and is expanding into other instruments. Scecina has helped deepen his knowledge of and his interest in music.

He was in the honors concert band class as a freshman and sophomore and took part in extracurricular music opportunities like Rock Band and the pep band. He currently takes Music History and Appreciation and Composition classes from music teacher **Chris Ritchie**.

"If there is one thing that got me interested, it was **Mr. (Donnie) Glowinski** (former Scecina music teacher) and Mr. Ritchie," he said.

In junior high school at Lourdes, he took part in the East Deanery Band Festival, hosted by Scecina during Catholic Schools Week for East Deanery students.

"The whole thing was really fun and really exciting to be part of it," said Anthony. "Hopefully, by the end of the school year, I'll compose something. I definitely think that's something I need to get into now, composing music," he said. "You enjoy playing other people's music, but you can get more freedom in composing in your style."

This year he's backed off the music extracurriculars to try some new Scecina opportunities: Student Council and Student Ambassadors. He also has played soccer for three years and has been in the Archery Club for two. He said he might return to pep band or Rock Band in his senior year.

"This was my year to balance out some, because junior year is a tough year, academically," he said. "I want some time to just enjoy myself before I completely furl myself into music."

He's also formed a band with some other Scecina students. "We're just a bunch of people hanging out and playing music and having fun," he said.

Anthony does plan a music career, but not as a performer, he said. He's considering colleges such as Berklee College of Music in Boston or Belmont University in Nashville.

"I'm looking more into the technical side, music production and audio engineering, working in recording studios," said Anthony.

## SECTIONAL CHAMPIONS

The 2019 Crusaders volleyball team had one of its strongest seasons ever, winning the Indiana Crossroads Conference and their first IHSAA Sectional title in 14 years. It was the first time they won both the conference and Sectional titles in the same year.

They had home-court advantage for the Sectional tournament and beat Irvington Prep 3-0 to advance to a rematch with Triton Central. Led by **Abbey McCoy** '23 and **Mallory Cox '21**, the girls beat Triton Central in straight sets. The win left only the Covenant Christian Warriors in the way of the Crusaders and their first Sectional in 14 years. In front of a packed house, seniors **Madi Beriault** (17 assists), **Alexis Carr** (22 digs), and **Jodena Livesay**

(five blocks) led the way. The girls handled the Warriors in straight sets. Throughout all three Sectional games, the Crusaders did not drop a set.

"A lot of people doubted us after having lost nine seniors," said **Madi Beriault**, one of three cocaptains. "I think we surprised a lot of people, and we surprised ourselves."

Coach **Kevin Griffin '76** said the team knew it had a lot of rebuilding to do.

"Our main goal as individuals was to push each other to keep improving each practice and match, and the main team goal that motivated us was to win conference," he said. "We achieved these goals by winning 10 of our last 12 matches and becoming Co-Conference champs with our win over Triton Central."

The girls' season finally ended on Oct. 26 at the Regional tournament. They battled Southmont to five sets but dropped the match.

## ON THE RUN

Crusader cross country runner Jacob Sitzman '21 advanced for the second consecutive year to the IHSAA Semi-State Cross Country Meet. He's been an All-Conference runner every year and MVP of the boys cross country team for the past two years. Jacob ran his personal best of 17:19 this year for the 5K.

## **SEASON RECAP**

## **BOYS TENNIS**

Former assistant coach **Nick** Batuello took over as head coach of the Crusaders. Coach Batuello inherited an inexperienced team that depended on the senior leadership of captains Alex Andrews, Michael Black, and Daniel Rudicel. The Crusaders beat Cardinal Ritter 3-2 and Speedway to finish the Speedway Invite 2-1 and earn first place. At the Indiana Crossroads Conference Tournament, Rudicel '20 and Patrick Berg '23 made school history when they won No. 1 doubles and became conference champs. With the experience gained by underclassmen this season, Coach Batuello and the Crusaders look to build off this year's 6-8 record.

## **CROSS COUNTRY**

**'14** led both the boys and girls teams to invitational wins. The boys placed first at the Cardinal Ritter Invitational Fox and Hound, while the girls team won the Scecina Invite. At the ICC races at Blue River Valley Park, **Jacob Sitzman '21** finished fifth and **Liam Rolfson '21** finished 10th in the boys race and **Abby Page '20** finished 10th in the girls race to earn All-Conference honors. During the city meet at Graham Park,

Sitzman finished fifth to earn All-City Honors. At the Mount Vernon Sectional, Sitzman (17th), Rolfson (35th), Page (23rd), and **Kaylee**Spears '21 (42nd) finished high enough in their respective races to advance to Regionals. Despite losing his shoe during the race, Jacob Sitzman finished 22nd at the Rushville Regional and moved on to Semi-State.

## **FOOTBALL**

The Crusaders came into the 2019 season knowing they had to replace a lot of offensive firepower from last year's Sectional championship team. Following the leadership of senior captains Luke Leffler, Eli Phillips, **Luke Traylor**, and **Liam Wright**, the Crusaders hit the ground running, winning their first four games. In the season opener against Shenandoah, Indiana University commit **David** Baker '20 stole the show with a 10-yard touchdown catch and three interceptions. For the CYO Night game against Beech Grove, TyiShaun Woods '20 put on a show for the future Crusaders with a schoolrecord 329 yards rushing and six touchdowns.

On defense, the Crusaders controlled the line of scrimmage with five players finishing among the all-time list for tackles for a loss in a season (seniors Phillips 27, Woods 14, Leffler 13, Wright 13, and junior **Myles Dais** 14). The Crusaders finished the season with an 8-4 record and earned **Ott Hurrle** his 200th win as the head coach of the Crusaders and his 201st overall (68th winningest coach all-time in the state of Indiana and 20th among active coaches).

Even though the 2019 football season ended without bringing home any hardware, the seniors put their stamp all over the record books.

Woods set the school record for points and touchdowns in one game (36 points and six touchdowns vs. Beech Grove). He was first in rushing touchdowns in a game (four vs. Cascade and Centerville), and set school records for points in a season (170) and for rushing yards in a game (329) vs. Beech Grove. He took over second place in career scoring (234) and tied **Donald Winston '96** for 100 plus rushing yard games in a season (10). He also tied the school record for rushing touchdowns in a season (24) and is second in career rushing.

Baker finished first in career receptions (181), receiving yards (2,550), and receiving touchdowns (32), and second-most interceptions in a game (three against Shenandoah).

Wright had the longest fumble return in school history (67 yards vs. Speedway).

**Thiery McCormick-Messer** finished eighth in most receptions in a career (59), ninth in career pass breakups (12), 11th in career interceptions (8),



10th in career receiving touchdowns (7), and 15th in career receiving yards (798).

Phillips finished second in tackles for a loss in a season (27, one behind first place), eighth most in career tackles for a loss (38, one behind his dad, **Chris Phillips '93**, who had 39 career tackles for a loss), seventh most sacks in a season (8.5, bumping his dad to eighth place with eight), and 18th in career sacks (9.5).

Traylor finished first in career passing percentage (64%), fifth in completions in a season (101), 15th in career completions (105), and 10th in passing yards in a season (1,283), touchdowns (34), second in rush yards in a season (1,721), sixth in career rushing yards (2,388), first in career tackles (381), seventh in career sacks (13), first in defensive points in a career (802), and first in career special teams tackles (52).

## **BOYS SOCCER**

In Jesse Purvis' '06 final season as head coach, the Crusaders set out to make it a special one. Led by senior captains William Curiel, Eduardo Curvo, Brandon Escobar, Jeffrey Green, and Julian Gonzalez, the team won five of their first six games.

When ICC foe Speedway traveled to Scecina, Coach Purvis showed great sportsmanship late in the game, with the score tied, when the referees called a goal for the Crusaders that clearly did not go through the netting. Coach Purvis explained to the referees how the ball can create the illusion of being a goal with Scecina's nets, yet not actually go into the goal.

The boys lost that game in penalty kicks but learned a valuable lesson in sportsmanship from Coach Purvis. Despite that heart-breaking loss, the boys kept fighting and won the 2019 Indiana Crossroads Conference Championship.

The Crusaders finished with a 10-4-1 record that included winning the Hamilton Heights Husky Invitational. Gonzalez and **Garrett Nolan '21** earned All-Conference honors and Curiel and Escobar earned All-City honors.

## GIRLS SOCCER

Led by captains **Amori Curiel '21**, Olivia Smith '21, and Faith White '21, the girls got off to a hot start, winning their first two games. Madelynn Martin '22 led the team in scoring with 16 goals. Smith led the way for the Crusader defense with 56 steals to go along with nine goals and seven assists. First-year soccer player Allie Minton '21 took over as goalie for the Crusaders and had 143 saves on 194 opponent shots on goal. The girls finished the season with a 6-8 record with a winning record in the Indiana Crossroads Conference (4-3) for the first time in years. Curiel, Martin, and Smith earned All-Conference honors.

## **VOLLEYBALL**

The 2019 volleyball team made Scecina history. Not only did the girls win their first Sectional title since 2005 (see story on Page 10), they also won both the Sectional and conference championships in the same year for the first time. Led by captains Madi Beriault '20, Alexis Carr '20, Jodena Livesay '20 and **Sophia Petrone '20**, the Crusaders opened the season with a 3-1 upset of 4A power New Palestine. The girls played a difficult regular-season schedule to prepare for conference and the postseason. They dropped a midseason conference game to Cardinal Ritter. Against Triton Central for the conference championship at the end of the year, the Crusaders took care of business, beating the Tigers 25-21, 25-21, 25-19 to win the ICC.

Beriault, a La Salle University commit, led the Crusaders in assists with 741, to go along with 91.4 serve percentage. Carr, a libero, led the Crusaders in digs (526), serve receptions (431), aces (86) and serve percentage (93.4%). McCoy led the team with 352 kills and a 39.6 kills percentage.

Beriault, Carr, and McCoy received both All-Conference and All-City honors.





## SCECINA ALUMNI SPOTLIGHT ANGIE (BEWSEY) LACY '88

Occupational Therapist Founder, Project Play

The kids didn't have any toys to play with. Or the toys were inappropriate or broken and missing pieces.

That was heartbreaking — and just unacceptable — for Scecina graduate **Angie (Bewsey) Lacy'88**.

For 24 years, Angie has been an occupational therapist with Central Indiana First Steps, a program that serves children from birth to 3 years of age. Her work took her into the families' homes, where she often found there were no toys or the toys were not age appropriate.

Angie founded Project Play to give families appropriate toys for their children's development.

"Many families struggle to provide the necessities for their families, such as shelter, food, and clothing; therefore, toys are not always something that a family can afford," she said. "I believe strongly in the power of play and that toys are important to help with development. I always knew there was something that I could do to help with this. Over the years, this weighed on my heart, and I finally decided in 2016 that it was time to put my ideas into action."

That's how Project Play was born in 2016. The nonprofit founded by Angie operates solely from donations of new and used toys and books and monetary donations and serves children from birth through the teen years. Her home garage on the Eastside of Indy is Project Play's headquarters, full of neatly organized groups and storage containers of toys.

Project Play receives referrals for families needing toys. There are no financial qualifications to receive a referral. Once a referral is received, each child receives five toys and five books and then the toy bag is delivered to their home. And it's not solely a Christmas project.

"We believe children need toys all year, not just for Christmas," Angie said.

Since its founding, Project Play has provided toys and books to over 700 children.

The group finds the children who need toys by partnering with agencies and organizations that serve children and families.

"With the help of social media and word of mouth, we have been able to build our referral base," Angie said. "We know that there are many more children in need, so we always appreciate when people share the information about our organization."

Receiving a Catholic education at Scecina instilled in her the value of helping others, Angie said.

"Scecina's motto is 'Give That Little Extra.' That is something that I never forgot and try to live by every day. Scecina provided me with many role models that lived that motto."

She says Scecina also offered a great education that prepared her for college. Classes in science and psychology helped spur her interest in becoming an

occupational therapist, said Angie, who began her career at Riley Hospital for Children.

Angie has three children who are graduates of Scecina (Sam '14, Zach '16, and Hannah Burck '19) and eighth-grader Anthony will start at Scecina next year.

Angie is a big advocate for all children. She also is a preschool teacher at Downey Avenue Cooperative Preschool.

She said her work with Project Play has been enormously rewarding.

"I now have such a sense of relief that more children are now receiving toys and books, whereas before, they may not have had access to them. I also know that there are many more families and children that could benefit from a referral to Project Play," she said. "It is very exciting to see the children's faces when we deliver their toy bags to them. It is also nice to see the relief on the parents' face that their children now have toys to play with and books to read. I have met some amazing families through my work with Project Play, families that are very grateful."

Project Play accepts donations of cash and new or gently used toys (but not toy weapons or used stuffed animals) with the money used to buy toys. They will even pick up toys if you are in the Indianapolis metropolitan area. Learn more at **projectplayinc.org**.








## 2018-19 OPERATING REVENUE



# HEY HOOSIERS! GET CREDIT FOR GIVING

Do you live in Indiana? Would you like to help a child receive a quality education at Scecina? Would you like to be eligible to take advantage of a 50 percent credit against your individual or corporate state tax liability?

If your answer is "yes" to all of three questions, you should learn more about the School Scholarship Tax Credit (SSTC).

A tax credit is available for individuals or corporations who donate to a certified scholarshipgranting organization (SGO). An SGO is an entity that awards scholarships to eligible students. Last year, 277 students from low-income families attending Scecina received assistance through this program.

Those who have donated to an approved SGO are eligible to take advantage of a 50 percent credit against their individual or corporation state-tax liability. As of Dec. 2, 2019, the state had just over

\$9 million in remaining tax credits out of the \$15 million allocated for the fiscal year ending in July 2020.



It's simple to donate in three steps through Scecina's SGO, which is the Institute for Quality Education (i4qed):

- To make your online donation, go to: https://sgo.i4qed.org/ donate.
- Choose among making a onetime donation, a recurring monthly donation, or a stock or securities donation. (You can even make your donation a memorial gift to a loved one.)
- Select Scecina Memorial High School from the "Select School" pull-down menu.

You will receive an acknowledgement from IQE and later a Tax Credit Certification Number you will use to file your state income taxes.

# MICHAEL F. TROY '58: GOLD-MEDAL SWIMMER

Nov. 3, 1940 - Aug. 3, 2019

Mike Troy, Scecina Class of 1958, died Aug. 3, 2019, in Arizona. He was 78.

Mike was a two-time 1960 Olympic swimming gold medalist who appeared on the cover of *Sports Illustrated* magazine.


He swam under Coach Doc Counsilman while attending Indiana University, setting NCAA and world swim records.

In the 1960 Summer Olympics in Rome, he won an individual gold medal in the 200 butterfly and another gold medal as a

member of the USA 800-meter freestyle relay team. He was 19 years old.

After college, he became an officer in the U.S. Navy and joined the Navy Underwater Demolition/SEALS. He earned a Silver Star for his combat service during the Vietnam War. The Silver Star is the U.S. Armed Forces' third-highest personal decoration for valor in combat.

He founded the Gold Medal Swim School in Chandler, Ariz., where he mentored young swimmers. In 2004, Mike was named national Teacher of the Year by the

U.S. Swim School Association, according to the Arizona Republic, and he served as national director of the USA Paralympic swim team.

Mike has been inducted into the International Swimming Hall of Fame, the Indiana University Hall of Fame, and the Helms Arco Hall of Fame.
