Stan Epperson Scholarship Application

As part of his generous and forward-looking spirit, Mr. Epperson is establishing a renewable, four-year scholarship for one or a small group of Scecina students who accomplish the following:

As an 8th grader:

1. Submit the completed essay application according to the instructions below by Friday, March 8, 2024.
2. Complete the Scecina Financial Aid Application by Friday, March 15, 2024, and demonstrate high family financial need.

As a Scecina freshman through senior:

3. Earn a grade point average of 3.0 or higher every year at Scecina.
4. Participate in one or more Scecina athletic programs every year.
5. Participate in one or more Scecina non-athletic extracurricular activities every year.
6. Consistently demonstrate positive school conduct every year at Scecina.

The following questions are the essay application for the Stan Epperson Scholarship (in addition to the Scecina Financial Aid Application). In this document, please answer the following questions in the student's own words. Final instructions for submitting your essay application are below.

1. Why did you choose Scecina as your high school, and how will this choice benefit your future?
2. During your 8th grade year, what school sport or sports have you played, are you currently playing, and/or will you play?
3. During your 8th grade year, what non-athletic school club or activity have you participated in, are currently participating in, and/or will you participate in?
4. What sport or sports do you plan to play during your freshman year at Scecina?
5. What non-athletic club(s) or activity(ies) do you plan to participate in during your freshman year at Scecina?
