- 2. Your goals for the future.

A check in the amount of \$750 will be written and made payable to the student. The funding must be used for one or more of the following purposes:

- Tuition Assistance
- Housing
- Books or technology needs.

A committee including the principal, Catholic theology department chair, and athletic director will make recommendations of three to five students to the Hurrle family, who will make the final decision. The recipient will be announced at Senior Awards Day.
