A great Catholic school builds Christian community and upholds the dignity of every individual in all activities. Scecina's new chapel invites students into an intimate Mass experience

and a convenient place to pray or meditate. Every year, all students take Catholic Theology class, perform community service projects, and can experience a Christian retreat away from the activities of their daily lives.

Many expenses are rising, especially venue rental and transportation increases of more than \$25,000 for class retreats.



TUITION ASSISTANCE Investing in Youth

Our Catholic faith motivates us to make Scecina available to all our students, regardless of family income or circumstances. Scecina provides tuition assistance to 99% of all students through merit scholarships and/or need-based financial aid.

The Indiana Choice Scholarship (voucher) provides about 40 percent of the full Scecina tuition, and most families need much more support. FACTS, the company we retain to assess families' financial aid applications and ability to pay tuition, finds 45 percent of our families who apply for aid cannot afford a single tuition payment.


This year, Scecina has increased services for English Language Learners and added career concentrations in marketing, accounting, computer science, and media communications.
