HEALTH AND WELLNESS EDUCATION – Fulfills the Indiana Department of Education’s requirement for a Health credit for graduation. This will be an online class, completed during summer school hours at Scecina, with a classroom teacher for guidance and help. Priority areas include promoting personal health and wellness, physical activity, and healthy eating; promoting safety and preventing unintentional injury and violence; promoting mental and emotional health, a tobacco free lifestyle and an alcohol- and other drug-free lifestyle; and promoting human development and family health. A Chromebook will be provided.
